FAQs

When is KidsCare open?

KidsCare follows the Greece Central School District calendar and is open on school days. The 2022-23 KidsCare program will open on September 7 and is closed when school is closed throughout the school year (except for February and Spring break). Morning participants can arrive as early as 7 a.m. and afternoon participants can be picked up as late as 6 p.m.

Can I select the days my child attends?

Yes. Parents can pick any combination of days. There is, however, no discount for students who only attend one day a week or four days a week.

What is the student/staff ratio?

We strive to maintain a ratio of 10 students for every staff member.

What training do staff members receive?

All KidsCare employees receive annual training in areas including health and safety, childhood development, supervision, risk avoidance and child abuse prevention. Staff are also certified in first aid and CPR.

Are snacks provided?

Yes, students in the PM programs receive a daily snack.

What if my situation changes and I no longer need KidsCare?

We ask that you provide two weeks notice if you intend to leave the program for any reason.

How would I be billed?

We use the online MySchoolBucks platform for payment. Bills are generated monthly.
