LEVEL UP INFORMATION SHEET: WEEK 1

On December 10, Greece Central School District residents will vote on a capital improvement project that will enhance every school without increasing the tax levy. The proposal, called "Level Up," focuses on maintaining our facilities and updating classrooms to better support the changing needs of our students. Below is a brief overview of the project. This is the first in a series of information sheets that will be shared with the community in the weeks leading up to the vote.





Update

This portion of the project would reconfigure and add a number of classrooms



and support services spaces districtwide to meet the needs of a changing student

population. This portion of the proposal includes \$5 million set aside for a potential addition to one of the elementary schools, contingent on a detailed study to determine the most pressing need among Brookside, Paddy Hill, or the Greece Community Early Learning Center.

Upkeep

This portion of the project includes high-priority maintenance and replacement projects at every school as identified in the 2021 Building Condition Survey.

Work varies by location, but includes things like roof, window and flooring replacement, bathroom upgrades, and the replacement



of mechanical equipment including boilers, chillers and exhaust fans.

Upside

School tax levy will not increase as a result of this project.

We hold votes on capital improvement projects about every five years to ensure our physical assets are well maintained and to protect taxpayer investments. Being proactive enables us to take advantage of New York State building aid, avoid costly emergency repairs, and prevent increases in the tax levy. When state aid is paired with district capital reserve funds, *Level Up* can be completed at no additional cost to taxpayers.
