What's Included in the Budget Proposal for Elementary Schools?

Voters will be asked to decide on the Greece Central School District's 2023-24 proposed budget on May 16. Here's a look at some of the items included in the budget that directly impact elementary schools.

NEW EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAMS

The proposed budget expands funding for early intervention programs. We've increased access to literacy and math intervention programs to help all students meet or exceed grade level expectations. The proposal also includes funding for a new full-day pre-kindergarten program at our Early Learning Center.

ENHANCED SCHOOL SECURITY

Ensuring the physical safety of our students and staff is a critical responsibility. Greece employs 35 full-time security personnel. School staff receive annual training in threat assessment, therapeutic crisis intervention, and emergency preparedness. We've also added safety monitoring tools and new technology to safeguard our schools from a variety of potential physical and cyber threats.

MORE FREE CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES

In response to requests from families, we've added clubs and activities for elementary school students. Most of these experiences are free and appeal

> to a range of interests including music, art, sports, games, and STEM. More than 1,000 families took advantage of these opportunities last year.

MORE COURSE OPTIONS

Greece has one of the most expansive course catalogs in New York State. We offer 78 courses that are eligible for college credit as well as the New Visions, Early College High School, and AVID programs. Those interested in career and technical education (CTE) can choose from 8 district career pathway programs and 20 BOCES 2 WEMOCO programs, ensuring that there is something for everyone.

Extracurricular options are an important part of the school experience. Based on feedback from students and families, we've added musical performance opportunities and clubs including Esports and rowing. Athletic options have


also been expanded to include modified track and field, girls varsity flag football, and JV golf.
